"parental notification" proposal, which has stirred controversy in Minnesota, says that teachers must give "written consent" to sex with students under the age of 16, get permission from the student's parent or guardian, and give the parent or guardian at least 48 hours to get involved before engaging in any sexual activity. The measure, which will appear on the ballot this fall, would prohibit Minnesota educators from having sex with students on school property or while acting in their official capacity. Opponents, who want the measure scrapped, argue that the language is an attempt to legitimize pedophilia. "What these people don't understand is that pedophiles already have a pretty open policy of behavior — unfortunately, they're not being arrested enough," Dan McGrath, president of the Minnesota Catholic Conference, told NBC News. "At least this would put a stop to those who are innocently involved, who think this is OK." The Minnesota Catholic Conference has pledged to spend \$1.5 million to get
